

#### Identified Stakeholders by Country [%]



#### Identified Stakeholders by Category [%]





## Call4Action - urgent

- Create a (joint) management structure.
- Promotion of understanding of neighbouring country's culture and organisation of linguistic training when needed *regular exchange* need to be establish.
- School exchanges regular exchange need to be establish.
- Organisation of joint training courses and technical meetings for managers and field staff regular exchange need to be establish.
- Develop common data collection formats, indicators, monitoring and evaluation methods *especially important for the (joint) management of the core zone.*
- Implement joint demonstration projects.
