Why Capitalization Matters?















INTERREG DANUBE Programme has designed a Thematic Capitalisation Strategy in 2016 with the aim of fostering and exploiting synergies among funded projects across Europe. Capitalization activities enable actors located in the Danube region to fill knowledge-gaps via complementary thematic specialisation, experiences, methodological approaches created within and beyond the Danube region. Capitalization may take several forms from joint communication activities, exchange of policy recommendations and methodologies to jointly organized events and training sessions.

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DA-SPACE – Open Innovation to Raise Entrepreneurship Skills and Public Private Partnership in Danube Region

What?

The aim is to create an open innovation ecosystem by piloting a model of open innovation labs, in which companies, public authorities, universities and the civil society can create fundaments for innovation together with young talents.

The results emerging from the pilot will lead to the development of a strategy to boost innovation and entrepreneurial skills in the Danube:

- Pursues an open innovation approach to set the framework condition for innovation in the Danube Region
- Boost entrepreneurial mindset and skills
- Addresses the missing link between great ideas of young talents and sustainable business creations

Who?

Local Public Authorities, Higher Education and Research, SMEs, Business Support Organizations, Young Talents

How?

Launch of 7 open innovation labs in the Danube Region to create fundaments for innovation. The cooperation among different stakeholders on a national and transnational level will generate new solutions and raise the entrepreneurial skills of all the actors involved.

Developing 100 co-creation projects in which the young talents can work on real business cases and create new solutions.

Establish a sustainability strategy to lay the ground for further sustainable cooperation with key actors on a local level.

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Excellence-in-ReSTI – Excellence in research, social and technological innovation project management

What?

Advancing the competences of project management methodologies, leadership, administration and management of different kinds of innovation projects: technological, social and research-based. The objective is to create an environment in the Danube Region where knowledge on managing such projects is readily available to the interested stakeholders. By developing e-learning modules, easy-to-use checklists, and relevant strategies, the quality of project development and implementation of research and (social and technological) innovation projects, as well as the employability of young graduates, project managers and administrators dealing with such projects will be enhanced. Providing specific support to young project managers of in order to increase the, as well as the knowledge, skills and capacities, and hence the employability of young project managers.

Who?

Young graduates and project managers employed at project implementing public and private institutions; education and training centres, higher education institutions; public authorities funding and supporting projects.

How?

19 innovative online courses focusing on the skills closely related to the acquisition and management of R&D&I projects, which will serve as the background for a full transnational intercultural academic curriculum

for young managers and administrators to be implemented in academic year 2018/19 as a pilot course. Easy-to-use and service-oriented infodesk in order to provide tailored support to young managers and administrators and any interested stakeholders. Elaboration of a background analysis, roadmap and strategy on the current state-of-the-art, missing capacities and opportunities of the research, social and technological innovation landscape in the Danube Region.

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NewGenerationSkills – Unlocking the potentials for business and social innovation in the Danube Region by equipping young people with new generation skills

What?


Young generations have the potential to be pro-active engines of innovation and become change-makers in their local communities. However, 62% of young people in Central and Eastern Europe are not interested in starting their own business, whereas one in five would like to, but consider it too difficult. This weak entrepreneurial culture and missing innovation management capacities are recognized as a key challenge in the Danube Region. Unlocking youth's unexploited potential starts at local level by developing their skills and competences and creating an enabling environment to help them become their ideas grow their innovative ideas into ventures with high social added value, potentially taken up by the private & public sectors transnationally.

Who?

Local Public Authorities, Interest Groups including NGOs, Higher Education and Research, SMS, Youth aged between 15-29

How?

The project will upgrade existing cooperation mechanisms between its key target group of quadruple helix actors (local municipalities, organizations representing local youth, education, and the business sector) to create innovative local support schemes going beyond existing fragmented initiatives



taking the form of Innovation Labs joined in a transnational network. Offering a user-friendly e-learning environment to train the DIGITRANS method and to support the independent development of digital business models in the companies.

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SENSES – Strengthening Social Entrepreneurial Landscape through involving socially responsible corporate Practices in EntrepreneuRial Competences and Skills enhancement in the DANUBE region

What?

Creating a Transnational Network of social enterprise ecosystems that will jointly promote the social enterprise model as well as social innovations at large for the sustainable economic development in the form of more and better “socially responsible and innovative supply- and value-chains” in the Danube region:

- Empowering social enterprises through bridging public and private sector best practices,
- Better engaging social enterprises with their ecosystems,
- Creating an improved policy landscape for social enterprises

Who?

Social enterprises, socially responsible traditional businesses, social (impact) investors, policymakers, NGOs, academia

How?

60 hours “blended learning programme” co-designed with CSR socially responsible businesses, financial intermediaries and chambers – integrating classroom, web-based trainings with personalized mentoring – coaching by businesses. Creation of 150-250 market-based co-operations for more social innovations, better social entrepreneurial products / services as well as

increased knowledge-base in terms of markets, marketing expertise, customer relationships and sales. Policy Design through "Social Enterprise Strategy for the Danube region" and Regional Action Plans.
