

eGUTS STANDARDS

Preparation of State-of-the-art Report starts with SWOT analysis of mobility with special emphasis on e-mobility in the Danube Region. Connectivity and interoperability of e-transport systems are analysed including vehicles and infrastructure with additional analysis of existing e-mobility policies. In parallel, e-rules and specifications (including technical specifications) of electric vehicles, transport rules, charging stations, e-routes, etc. are analysed, grouped in Catalogue of e-rules and specifications.

This matching will result in eGUTS draft Standards that will be presented to and discussed with stakeholders in order to gain valuable feedback. The eGUTS draft Standards will be debated at Regional Strategy Platforms. Feedback from stakeholders will be collected and used for development of beta eGUTS Standards. The second round of discussion with stakeholders via RSPs will follow and will result in finalisation of eGUTS Standards. Once consent from all stakeholders is reached, eGUTS Standards are adopted unanimously by all consortium partners and are widely disseminated.
